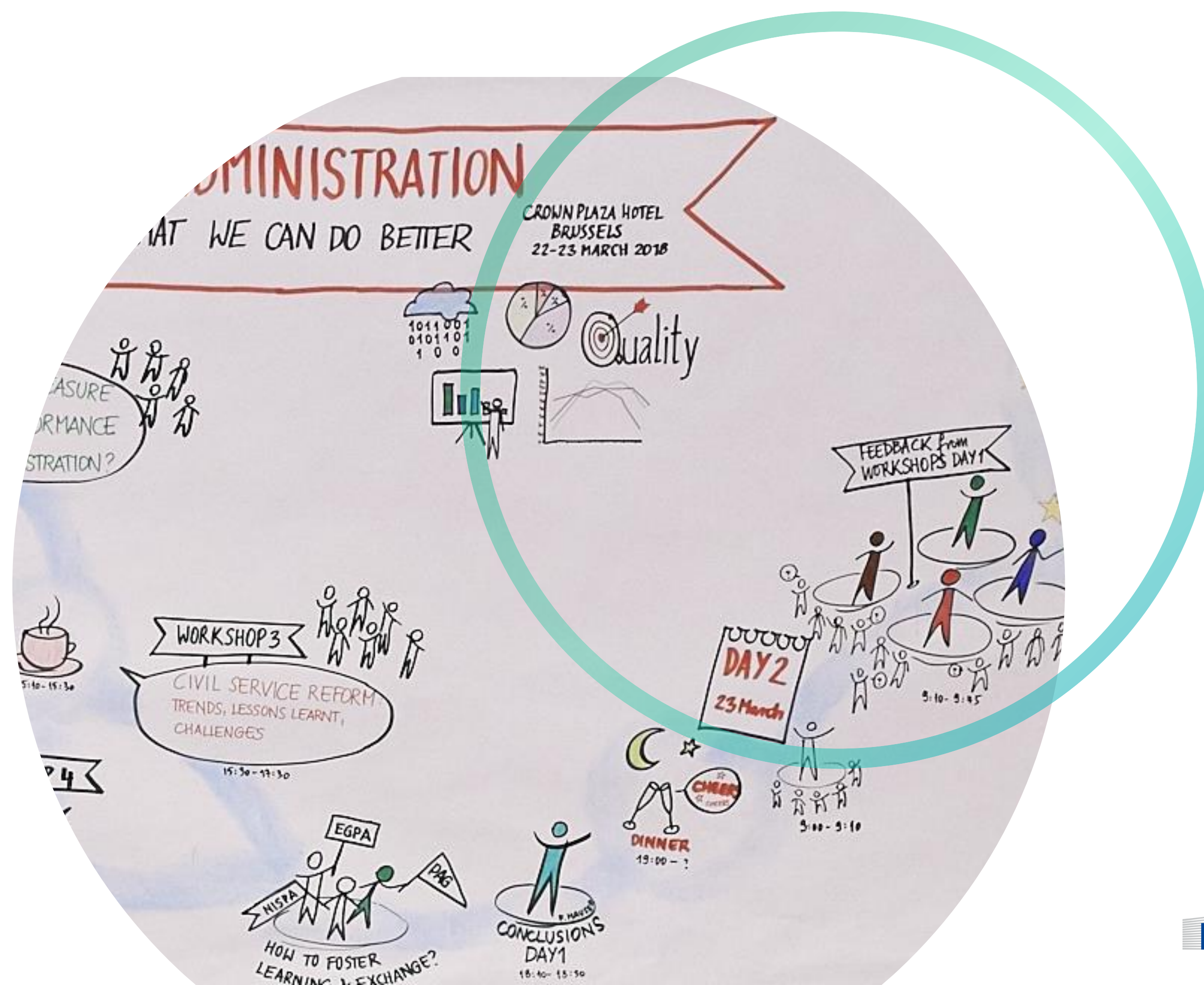

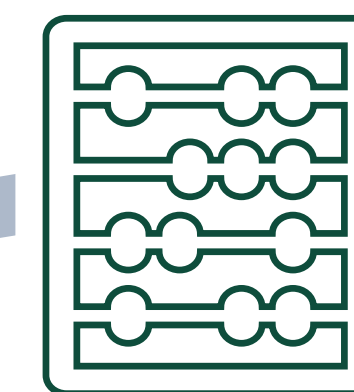

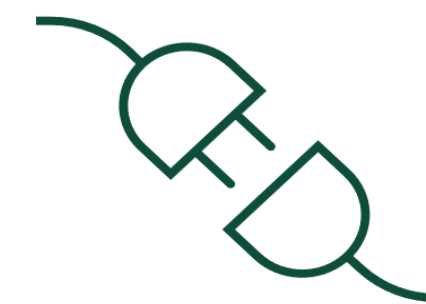

COMMISSION WORK 2023 PROGRAMME

A Union standing firm and united

A commitment to:

make a proposal on how to deepen and enhance administrative cooperation. This will allow for better synergies between the EU tools designed to strengthen capacities, especially at local and regional levels. It will also enable better management of investments and transformations, while ensuring full and effective implementation of EU policies.

PACE: CIVIL SERVANTS' EXCHANGE

- **Launch the TSI Public administration cooperation and exchange (PACE) project with the participation of 21 countries**
- **Organize a PACE workshop**
- **Revision of the TSI Regulation**

Responding also to the ambition to “strengthened mobility of public workers in Europe” defined in the [Strasbourg Declaration of the Public Administration Ministers](#)

SKILLS FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

- Create a compendium of existing and new **Competency Frameworks** (CF) for public administration
 - Promote EU CF for **polymaking, public buyers, funds management, use of evidence**
 - Work on CF for **digital, foresight**, etc.
- Work on **skills assessment tools and HR policies** (strategic workforce planning, policies for upskilling and reskilling)
- Work on new training content

EU ACADEMY FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

- Develop and make available directly to the civil servants in the EU Member States through the existing Commission online platform [EU Academy](#) a range of trainings on novel topics in public administrations.
- Materials will be freely accessible and could be translated to allow direct access to the public administrations at all levels in the MS.
- The material can be complemented by the guidance material and links to national sources.

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION EUROPA portal

- **PA Open Data Portal** – will provide visualization and download of all collected PA data for example in areas such as policy making, human resources, work of oversight institutions, etc.
- The website will also contain a collection of all qualitative **studies, country briefs and thematic reports**, developed under the EUPACK (European Public Administration Country Knowledge) project.
- **New studies** will be launched and published, focusing on public administration (sector) employment, skills, capabilities, effect of digital and demographic transformation

EU LEADERSHIP / THEMATIC CENTRES OF EXCELLENCE

- Collaborate with the networks of national schools for public administration and universities to link closer their programmes to the needed skills.
- Aim to build thematic centres of excellence for the provision of specific training on important novel topics (e.g. green budgeting, innovative public procurement, application of the legislation on artificial intelligence etc.) and promote cross- country training exchange.
- Develop communities of practices, including at management level

PLATFORM FOR TWINNING

- REFORM explores the existing Commission digital services, to create a platform that could allow **individual administrations** to connect with peers, exchange practices and create thematic communities of practice.
- Such platform could be useful also for finding partners in multi-country projects under the TSI and/or other programmes of the Commission, including using EU funding opportunities.
